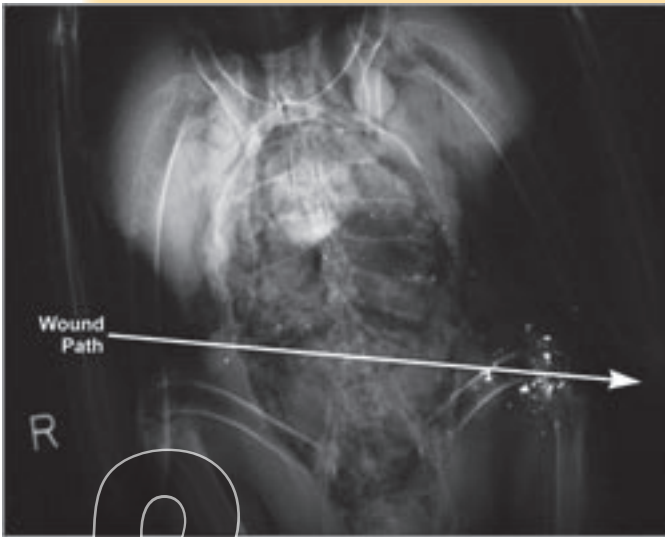

OBJECTIVES:
